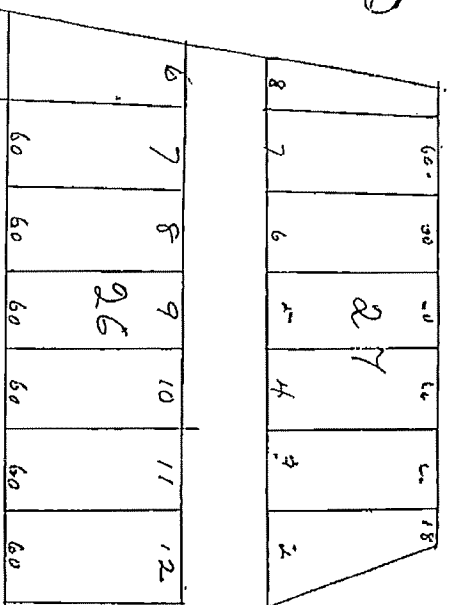

We the undersigned would pray that your body would pass an ordinance complying with sec 1616 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio, and grant the detachment of the parcel of land situated on the Island as described in the enclosed map.

An Ordinance to detach certain property.

Whereas a petition signed by various owners of lots situated in what is known as the Island as cross 73 Canal has been presented to the Council praying for the detachment of the same, and whereas the Council is satisfied there is good cause for such detachment that it exercises its discretion to the general interest and that the same should be made. Therefore Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Taylorsville, Washington County Ohio, that lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 in square XXVII, be and the same are detached from the Incorporation. In accordance with Chapter 5 Division 18, and sec 1616 of the Revised Statutes of Ohio and said lots attached to the Township of Taylorsville.

Detachment of Territory from the Municipal Corporation of Taylorsville. And incorporation thereof to the Township of Taylorsville, Washington County, Ohio, August 4th 1855.
By authority of section 1616 of the Revised Statutes, when the petition of owners of lots along the canal of the Island of the detached lots is presented, we as

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portion of the territory of the village of Lyonsville, in this County, to wit: Lots numbered 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8, in Division 27, and Lots numbered 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 in Square 26 with an accurate map or plat thereof, bearing to have the said described portion of territory detached from said village, the assent of the Council of said village, having been given in an Ordinance passed for that purpose, in pursuance of said action of the Council of said village, it is hereby ordered that said described lots or portion of territory be detached from said village of Lyonsville, and that the same be attached to the township of Harrison, contiguous thereto. And the County Auditor is hereby directed to certify this order for record in the plat book of the County Recorder as required by law.
