TUNNEL

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. General. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and Division 1 specification sections, apply to this section.

1.2 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

A. General. The Contractor shall provide the labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to furnish and install the tunnel in accordance with the plans and as specified herein.

1.3 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. Codes and Standards. Perform all work required to furnish and install the tunnel in compliance with applicable requirements of governing agencies having jurisdiction.

B. Regulations and Permits

1. General. Tunnels installed within the right-of-way of private companies or public authorities shall conform to the requirements and regulations of the respective companies and authorities. The Owner will acquire the necessary permits and installation rights. The Contractor shall be responsible for the payment of any costs due to the requirements and regulations, of whatever nature, including watchmen and supervision.

1.4 SUBMITTALS

- A. Miscellaneous. Furnish samples, manufacturer's product data, test reports, and materials certifications, as required.
- B. Submittal. The Contractor shall submit evidence of previous experience in this type of work, or that a superintendent with the required experience shall be continuously employed on the construction until the tunnel work is completed.
- C. Approval Drawings. Shop drawings and schedules of procedure shall be submitted to the Engineer/Architect for review or comments prior to the start of construction. Fabrication and installation shall be in accordance with the shop drawings.
