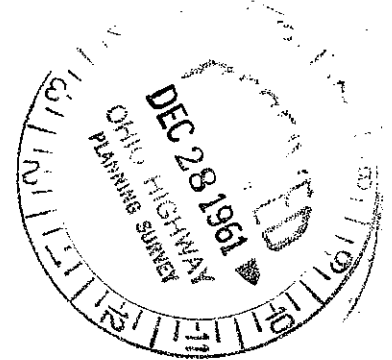

Gentlemen:

The following entry was made on the Journal of the Director of Highways December 15, 1961, Volume 46, Page 1293.

MUSKINGUM-PERRY COUNTIES - STATE ROUTE 75 - SECTION 0.00-26.57 GRANTED - EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 18, 1961.

Pursuant to Chapter 5511 of the Revised Code of Ohio, the Director of Highways of Ohio on April 20, 1960, approved a Relocation of a portion of S.R. 75, hearing having been held in Roseville, Ohio on March 30, 1960. This was recorded on Page 345, Volume 45, of the Journal of the Director of Highways. Said approval stated that the Abandonment of the Old Highway would not be effective until the Improvement of the New Location was accepted and Proper Entry made in the Journal of the Director of Highways.

In view of the Fact that the improvement of the above mentioned relocation has been accepted, Director Preston orders that the Abandonment referred to in the above mentioned Journal Entry be effective as of December 18, 1961, and that said former location hereby reverts to the Muskingum - Perry County Highway System and to the Village of Roseville Street System.
