There is also conveyed herein a right-of-way and easement for ingress and egress over lands in the Southeast Quarter of Section Seven (7), said land being reserved to the use of owners of the land in the Southwest Quarter of Section Seven (7), in a certain Deed from Emma Fawcett to the Penn Central & St. Louis Railway, dated January 7, 1901, and recorded in Deed Book 123, page 120, of the Muskingum County Deed Records, said roadway having been reserved for the use and enjoyment of the owner or owners of property lying in said Southwest Quarter, said roadway to connect with a like roadway 20 feet in width extending along the right-of-way and connecting with said county road on a line between said Sections Seven (7) and Eight (8), said use to exist until such time as the railway company shall by purchase of additional land lying North of said right-of-way provide an equally suitable and convenient lane or highway connecting with said county road. Said railway company to construct and maintain good and sufficient fences along each side of said 20 foot road or driveway. Reference is also made to the Deed from Byard Fawcett to the Penn Central and St. Louis Railway, dated June 25, 1901, and recorded in Book 124, page 555 of the Muskingum County Records, for a more particular description of said roadway. Reference is also made to the Deed from Emma Fawcett to the Penn Central and St. Louis Railway dated January 7, 1901, wherein said roadway was reserved out of said conveyances, said Deed being recorded in Deed Book 123, page 120, of said records.
