

Adams Mills

Part of Lots 15 & 16

Situated in the State of Ohio; County of Muskingum, Township of Cass:

Being a part of Lots 15 and 16 in the Town of Adams Mills (formerly the Town of Preston) Deed Book 1, Page 568 in Quarter Township 1, Township Three (3), Range Seven (7) and part of property now owned by Mary Maxine Corder and Recorded in Deed Book 1045, Page 398 of the Muskingum County Deed Records bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone found at the northwest corner of Lot 19 of the Plat of Preston (D.B. 1, Pg.568) now Adams Mills; thence N 17 51 13 W (the base of bearings for this description is true north by an observation of the sun) 60.00 feet to a point at the southwest corner of Lot 18; thence N 72 22 22 E along the south line of Lots 18 and 17 and the north line of Second Street 132.00 feet to a point at the southwest corner of Lot 16 ; thence N 17 51 13 W along the west line of Lot 16 a distance of 13.27 feet to an iron pin set at the true place of beginning for the following described parcel; thence along the north right of way of the Ohio Central Railroad (formerly the Coshocton Southern Railroad) N 76 22 59 E 84.09 feet to an iron pin set and passing from Lot 16 into Lot 15 at 66.18 feet; thence along the north line of said railroad on curve to the left having a radius of 5711.65 feet (the chord of which bears N 76 07 45 E 50.64 feet) an arc distance of 50.65 feet to an iron pin set on the east line of Lot 15 and the west line of a 16.50 foot alley; thence N 17 51 13 W along the west line of said alley and the east line of said Lot 15 a distance of 77.24 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of the Ohio Central Railroad (formerly the PCC and ST. Louis Railroad); thence S 72 14 00 W along the south line of said railroad and 44.00 feet south of said center line a distance of 134.38 feet to an iron pin set on the west line of Lot 16 and passing from Lot 15 into Lot 16 at 68.38 feet; thence S 17 51 13 E along the west line of said Lot 16 a distance of 67.71 feet to the true place of beginning containing 0.2238 of an acre of which 0.1176 of an acre is all of Parcel No. 10-20-07-04-000 in Lot 15 and 0.1062 of an acre is all of Parcel No. 10-20-07-05-000 in Lot 16.

Subject to all legal right of ways and easements on record.

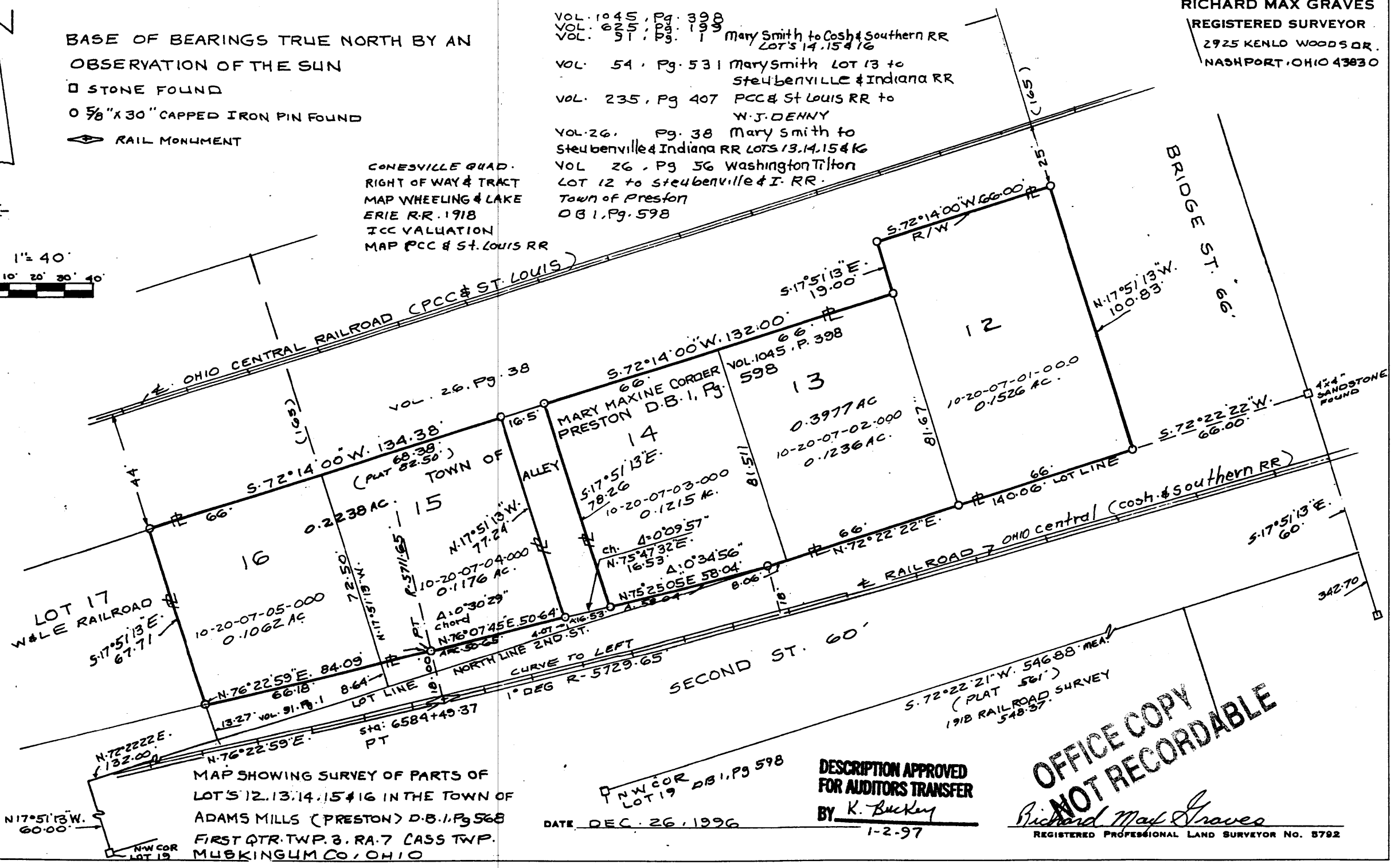
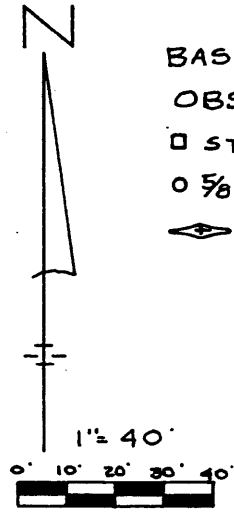
