DESCRIPTION FOR THREE SPRINGS FARM, INC. IN CASS TOWNSHIP, MUSKINGUM COUNTY, OHIO.

TRACT D
 PARCEL 1

Note: The angular variation between lines is based upon an azimuth North as taken from a Polaris Observation with a 90% probability of plus or minus three seconds. All pins indicated are 3/4" x 30" reinforcing bars with aluminum caps. All monuments indicated as set are 4 1/2" concrete monuments with aluminum caps.

Being a tract of land in the First Quarter, Range 7W, Township 3N, Cass Township, Muskingum County, Ohio which is further described as follows:

Beginning at a set steel pin on the North line of Muskingum County which point is also on the South line of lands of the Ohio-Erie Canal and is located by the following two (2) courses from a recovered stone at the Southwest corner of Lot 30 in Coshocton County:

1. S 88°11'14" E along the said South line of Muskingum County, a distance of one hundred seventy-seven and twenty-nine hundredths (177.29) feet to a set steel pin;

2. continuing S 88°11'14" E, a distance of two hundred four and seventy-four hundredths (204.74) feet to said beginning point;

thence, S 88°11'14" E along the said North line of Muskingum County, a distance of three hundred ninety-nine and eighty-four hundredths (399.84) feet to a concrete monument set on the North line of lands of Conrail Railroad;

thence, S 67°19'56" W along the said North line of lands of Conrail Railroad, a distance of one thousand two hundred sixty-two and sixty-seven hundredths (1,262.67) feet to a set steel pin on the East line of the Village of Adams Mills;

thence, N 01°27'49" W along the said East line of the Village of Adams Mills with the following three (3) courses"

1. N 01°27'49" W, a distance of seventeen and seventy-one hundredths (17.71) feet to a set steel pin at the Southeast corner of Lot 13 in the said Village of Adams Mills;

2. continuing N 01°27'49" W along the East line of said Lot 13, a distance of one hundred twenty-six and sixty-six hundredths (126.66) feet to a set steel pin at the Northeast corner of said Lot 13;

3. continuing N 01°27'49" W, a distance of thirty-seven and two hundredths (37.02) feet to a point on the South line of lands of the Ohio-Erie Canal;

thence, in a Northeasterly direction along the South line of the lands of the Ohio-Erie Canal with the following eight (8) courses:

1. N 72°02'33" E, a distance of one hundred thirty-five and thirty-two hundredths (135.32) feet to a point;

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2. N 72°16'49" E, a distance of one hundred and no hundredths (100.00) feet to a point;
3. N 67°39'04" E, a distance of one hundred and thirty-six hundredths (100.36) feet to a point;
4. N 69°25'38" E, a distance of one hundred three and fifty-eight hundredths (103.58) feet to a point;
5. N 61°02'50" E, a distance of one hundred and five hundredths (100.05) feet to a point;
6. N 66°35'56" E, a distance of one hundred and twenty-two hundredths (100.22) feet to a point;
7. N 66°15'23" E, a distance of one hundred and eighteen hundredths (100.18) feet to a point;
8. N 63°23'45" E, a distance of ninety-five and twenty-two hundredths (95.22) feet to the point of beginning.

thence, N 18°08'58" W, along the West line of said Lot 13 a distance of five and no hundredths (5.00) feet to a set steel pin at the said Northwest corner of said Lot 13;

thence, N 71°36'02" E along the North line of said Lot 13, a distance of one hundred fourteen and ninety-seven hundredths (114.97) feet to a set steel pin at the Northeast corner of said Lot 13;

thence, S 01°27'49" E along the East line of said Lot 13, a distance of one hundred twenty-six and sixty-six hundredths (126.66) feet to a set steel pin at the Southwest corner of said Lot 13;

thence, S 71°36'02" W along the South line of said Lot 13, a distance of seventy-eight and sixty hundredths (78.60) feet to a set steel pin at the Southwest corner of said Lot 13;

thence, N 18°08'58" W along the West line of said Lot 13, a distance of one hundred sixteen and seventeen hundredths (116.17) feet to the point of beginning.
