

Situated in Lot 5, in the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of Township 3 North, Range 8 West of the United States Military Lands; Cass Township, Muskingum County, Ohio [and being part of the property conveyed to Mitchell C. Taylor and Gail E. Taylor by a deed recorded in Deed Book 1086, page 502 (Aud. Par. #10-34-41-26-000, part)] and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning for a point of reference at a ¾ inch pipe found at the Northeast corner of the aforementioned Lot 5;

thence North 89° 55' 59" West, along the north line of said Lot 5 and along the south line of a tract conveyed to Gilbert E. Archer, Jr., and Marjorie M. Archer by a deed recorded in Deed Book 1152, page 654, a distance of 248.35 feet to a  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch rebar found, said point being the true place of beginning of this tract;

thence South 00° 03' 40" East, along the west line of a tract conveyed to Joseph E. Cronin and Joy R. Cronin by a deed recorded in Official Record Book 2180, page 596, a distance of 260.87 feet to a  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch rebar found;

thence South 23° 13' 39" East, continuing along the west line of the aforementioned Cronin tract, a distance of 294.04 feet to a <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch rebar found;

thence South 12° 20' 47" East, along the west line of a tract conveyed to Joseph E. Cronin and Joy R. Cronin by a deed recorded in Official Record Book 2180, page 595, a distance of 28.43 feet to a point in the center of Dutch Hill Road (Township Road 80);

thence the following three (3) courses along the center of Dutch Hill Road (Township Road 80):

- 1) South 36° 45' 16" West, a distance of 181.80 feet to a point;
- with a curve to the right having a radius of 293.82 feet; a chord bearing and distance South 57° 10' 28" West 205.03 feet; a tangent distance of 109.39 feet; and a central angle of 40° 50' 24"; an arc distance of 209.43 feet to a point;
- 3) South 77° 35' 41" West, a distance of 27.48 feet to a point;

thence North 34° 00' 02" West, through the aforementioned Taylor tract and passing an iron pin set at a distance of 20.00 feet, a total distance of 992.03 feet to an iron pin set on the north line of said Lot 5;

thence South 89° 55' 59" East, along the north line of said Lot 5 and along the south line of the aforementioned Archer tract, a distance of 740.34 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 9.2487 acres, subject to all legal road right of way and any valid and existing easements, restrictions, leases or other conditions of record.

The bearings used in this description are based on the bearings in the deed to Gary R. Hargraves, Jr., as recorded in Official Record Book 2154, page 638. Pertinent documents are all deeds mentioned; tax map; two (2) survey plats prepared by James M. Matchett, Reg. Surv. #7975, one (1) for Mitch Taylor dated June 25, 2007 and one (1) for Richard L. Spragg dated July 31, 2007. All iron pins described as set are  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch diameter, 30 inches long, solid reinforcing bars with plastic identification caps. All mention of Deed Books and Official Record Books refers to records on file in the Muskingum County Recorder's Office.
