## DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR RON THOMAS JOB#1579-1

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Falls:

Being part of Quarter Township #2, of Township #1, Range #8, of the US Military District, **being part of** the Ray Thomas Lumbertown, Inc. property recorded in Deed Book Volume 833, Page 323 of said county's deed records, further being known as Muskingum County **Auditor's Parcel Number 17-02-02-01-000**, and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at an iron pin (set) at the common Southern corner for Lots #23 and #24 of Stonehenge recorded in Plat Book 14, Pages 24 through 26, also being on the common line for Falls and Muskingum Townships;

- **#1- THENCE South 86 degrees 38 minutes 50 seconds East 152.18 feet** along said Township line to an iron pin (set);
- **#2- THENCE South 42 degrees 24 minutes 25 seconds West 69.16 feet** into said Quarter Township #4 and through said Lumbertown property to an iron pin (set);
- **#3- THENCE North 74 degrees 56 minutes 50 seconds West 45.53 feet** continuing through said Lumbertown property to an iron pin (set);
- **#4- THENCE North 68 degrees 23 minutes 15 seconds West 75.11 feet** continuing through said Lumbertown property to an iron pin (set);
- **#5-** THENCE North 22 degrees 35 minutes 10 seconds East 22.18 feet continuing through said Lumbertown property to the place of beginning, containing 0.13 acres.

The bearings within this description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid (Ohio South 1983) derived from GPS Observations. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).

This parcel is intended to be transferred to the owner of Lot #23 of Stonehenge recorded in Plat Book 14, Pages 24 through 26 and is not to be used as a separate building site or transferred as an independent parcel in the future without planning commission approval.
