Being all of Lot 35 in Fairview Subdivision #2 to Falls Township, Plat Book 9, Page 2 and being a part of Lot 34 and beginning at an iron pin found at the northwest corner of Lot 34; thence South 71° 00' 00" East 17.000 feet along the north line of Lot 34 to an iron pin set; thence South 12° 15' 44" West 176.035 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of Lot 34; thence North 78° 47' 00" West 30.000 feet along the south line of Lot 34 to an iron pin found at the southwest corner of Lot 34; thence North 16° 27' 42" East 179.058 feet along the west line of Lot 34 to the place of beginning. The tract as surveyed contains 0.096 acres, more or less, subject to all highways and easements of record.

Bearings in the above description are based on the west line of Lot 34 in Fairview Subdivision #2 to Falls Township, Plat Book 9, Page 2 bearing North 16° 27' 42" East.



Beginning at an iron pin found at the northwest corner of Lot 34; thence South 71° 00' 00" East 17.000 feet along the north line of Lot 34 to an iron pin set; thence South 12° 15' 44" West 176.035 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of Lot 34; thence North 78° 47' 00" West 30.000 feet along the south line of Lot 34 to an iron pin found at the southwest corner of Lot 34; thence North 16° 27' 42" East 179.058 feet along the west line of Lot 34 to the place of beginning. The exception as surveyed contains 0.096 acres, more or less, subject to all highways and easements of record.

Bearings in the above description are based on the west line of Lot 34 in Fairview Subdivision #2 to Falls Township, Plat Book 9, Page 2 bearing North 16° 27' 42" East.

Iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebar, 30 inches long with plastic identification caps set flush with the grand.


