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DEED DESCRIPTION

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskinguka Lowenip of Falls, bounded and described as follows: <u>FIRST PARCEL</u> Being a part of Lot Three Underwood's Subdivision in the Second Quarter of Township One, Range Seven, United States Nilitary Lands, and being the same premises described as First Parcel in Muskingum County Deed the same premises described as First Parcel in Muskingum County Deed Book 766, Page 41; beginning for reference at an axle found at the northeast corner of Lot 22 Skyline Acres as the same is designated and delineated upon Muskingum County Plat Book 9, Page 21; thence along the east line of said Lot 22 (the basis of bearings herein described) South 25 degrees 49 minutes 00 seconds East 39.08 feet to an iron pipe found at the southwest corner of land now by G. and K. Hothem (D.B. 623, Pg. 168) and the principal place of beginning; thence North 73 degrees 54 minutes 00 seconds East 211.17 feet to an iron pin set on the west line of Skyline Drive; thence along said west line on a curve to the left 42.43 feet (the chord of which, bears South 33 degrees 33 minutes East a distance of 42.37 feet) to an iron pin set; thence continuing along said west line South 38 degrees 47 minutes 00 seconds East 25.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence along the northwest line of land formerly owned by R. and M. Bucci (D.B. 704, Pg. 308) South 51 degrees 34 minutes 07 seconds West 149.88 feet to a 2 inch aluminum pipe found; thence along the north line of land formerly owned by H. Broom (D.8. 922, Pg. 330) North 87 degrees 35 minutes 46 seconds West 33.10 feet to a PK nail set; thence North 42 degrees 01 minutes 05 seconds West 20.00 feet to a PK nail set; thence South 48 degrees 08 minutes 38 seconds West 40.00 feet to an iron pin set on the southeast corner of said Lot 22; thence along the east line of Lot 22 North 25 degrees 49 minutes 00 seconds West 110.92 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing 0.485 acres, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.
