

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Falls, North Half, of Quarter Township #4, Township #1, Range #8, of the US Military District:

Being all of the prior deed reference Volume 981, Page 25, of said county's deed records, also being all of Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 17-17-55-02-77-000, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at an iron pin (found) at the Northwest corner of Lot #1, of Colonel Jackson Subdivision, as recorded in Plat Book #15, Pages 11 and 12, also being the Northwest corner of M. F. Morgan et. al. property as recorded in deed reference Volume 728, Page 347, and the Northeast corner of R. & M. Imlay property, as recorded in deed reference Volume 939, Page 142; thence along the North line of said Imlay property N 87 05 47 W 142.49 feet to an iron pin (found) at a common corner of said Imlay property and the Southeast corner of a 17.47 acre tract once owned by Charles Havens as recorded in deed reference Volume 26, Page 260 and referred to in the prior deed reference, also being the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- thence along the South line of said 17.47 acre tract S 63 07 11 W 464.99 feet to the center of Old State Route #146, currently described as being 9.20 feet Right of Station 76+59.8 of a center line survey for State Route #146, Section 10.31 as recorded in Plat Book 9, Page 63, from which two concrete monuments (found) for reference bear N 62 11 21 E 59.23 feet being 50 feet Left of Station 76+61.7, and S 62 11 21 W 70.84 feet being 80 feet Right of Station 76+57.7;
- #2- thence along the center line of Old State Route #146 N 36 41 00 W 662.90 feet to a point in the center of current County Road #660 Dillon School Drive also being on the North line of said 17.47 acre tract, from which two concrete monuments (found) for reference bear S 64 16 20 W 82.13 feet being 235 feet Right of Station 70+36.7, and N 05 03 28 E 57.21 feet being 135.60 feet right of Station 69+75.6;
- #3- thence along the North line of said 17.47 acre tract, also being the South line of a 10.97 acre tract once owned E. Knight as shown on a survey plat recorded in Deed Book Volume "I", Page 711 N 62 46 16 E 645.94 feet to an iron pipe (found) at the Northeast corner of said 17.47 acre parcel;
- #4- thence along the East line of said 17.47 acre tract S 20 57 58 E 660.67 feet to the place of beginning containing 8.356 acres.

The bearings within this description are based on the center line of Old State Route #146 as described in prior deed reference Volume 981, Page 25. Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, & Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness R.S.6885).

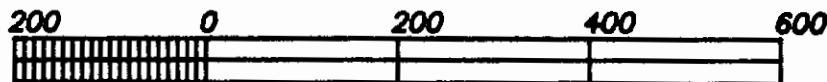

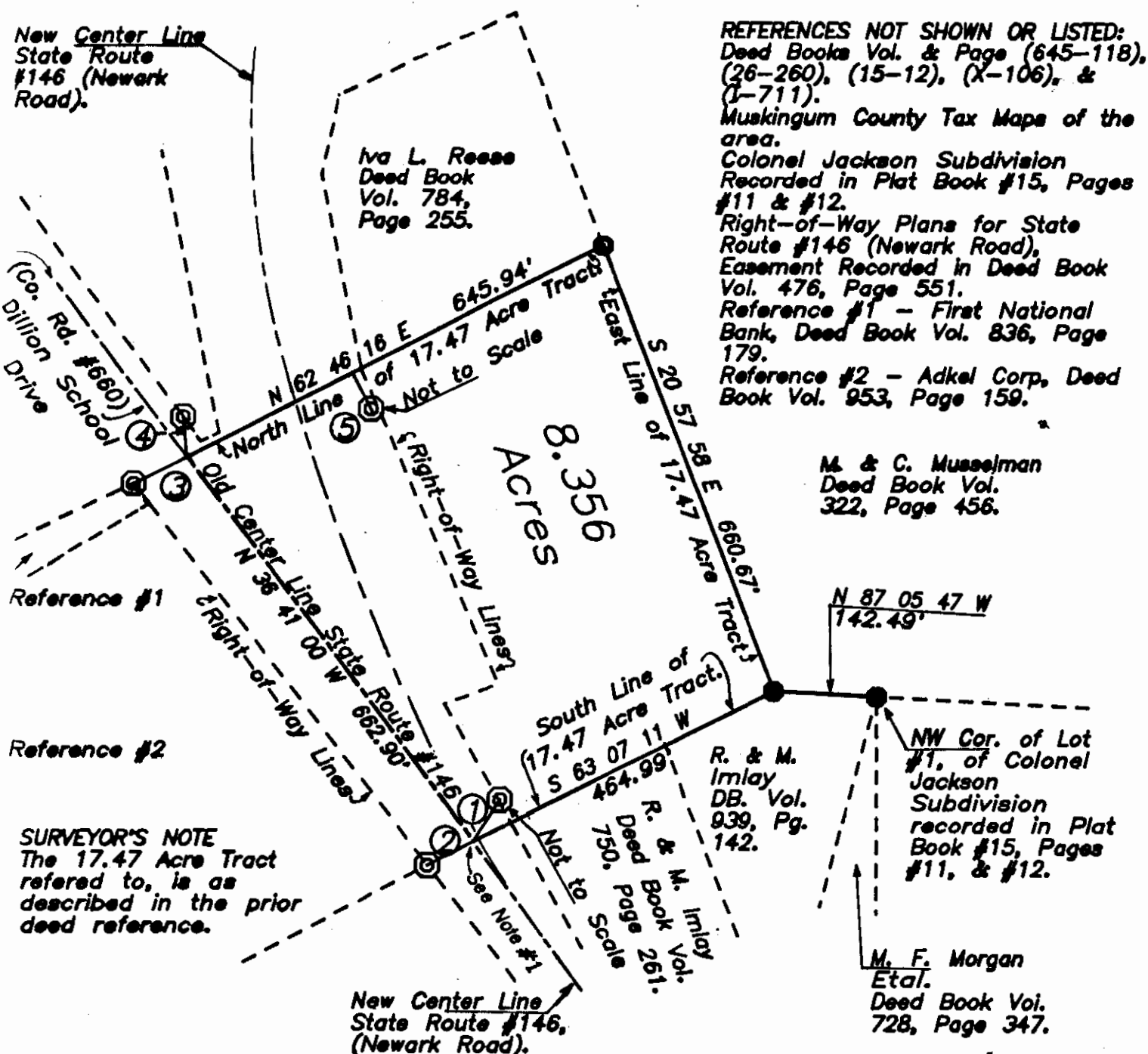
