

+- 0.01 Acre Split to an Adjoiner of Debra J. Williams Lands

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Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Falls, and being part of Ouarter Township 4, Township 1, Range 8, United States Military Lands, and being part of the lands presently owned by Debra J. Williams as per Official Record 2122, Page 4, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference at the most southerly corner of Lot 1, of Wildwood, a subdivision in Falls Township, as delineated in Plat Book 8, Page 89, of the Muskingum County Records;

Thence, (by deed), South 41 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, 45.00 to iron pin on the southerly side of Mound Road:

Thence (by deed), along the southerly side of said road, South 45 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds East, 184.60 feet to a point in the centerline of Highland Road, (Twp. Rd. 602);

Thence, (by deed), along the centerline of Highland Road, South 44 degrees 45 minutes 00 seconds west, 372,00 feet to a point on the southwest corner of lands presently owned by Debra J. Williams (OR 2122-4), and the north line of lands presently owned by the Federal National Mortgage Association, (OR 2219-857):

Thence along the south line of said Williams lands, and the north line of said Mortgage Association lands, South 45 degrees 15 minutes 00 East, 157.19 feet to an iron pin set, and the principal place of beginning, passing and iron pipe found at 20,00 feet;

Thence through said Williams lands the following two courses:

- 1.) South 88 degrees 47 minutes 55 seconds East, 21.61 feet to an iron pin set;
- 2.) South 18 degrees 18 minutes 13 seconds East, 32.85 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of said Williams lands, and the north line of said Mortgage Association lands;

Thence along the south line of said Williams lands, and the north line of Mortgage Association lands. North 45 degrees 15 minutes 00 seconds West, 44.95 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing 0.01 acres, more or less.

Subject to all legal recorded easements and right of ways.

Iron pins set are 5\8 inch rebars, 30 inches long, with plastic identification caps.

Bearings are based on the centerline of Highland Road, as being South 44 degrees 45 minutes 00 Seconds West, as per OR 2122-4.
