Being a part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, Quarter Township 1, Township 2, Range 5 bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone at the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of said Section 9; thence east 689.10 feet to an iron pin at the southwest corner of the premises conveyed to this Grantor by deed recorded in Deed Book 312, Page 218 and being the true place of beginning of the premises herein intended to be conveyed; thence north 26 degrees 41 minutes west 516.10 feet to an iron pin; thence east ^{717.20}~~727.20~~ feet to a point in the center of State Route #83; thence along said road south 10 degrees 19 minutes east 46.5 feet to a point; thence continuing along said road south 14 degrees 37 minutes east 300 feet to a point; thence continuing along said road on a curve to the left having a radius of 153.26 feet an arc distance of 154.39 feet (the long chord of which bears south 43 degrees 24 minutes east 147.98 feet) to a point; thence continuing along said road south 72 degrees 20 minutes east 56.44 feet to a point in said centerline; thence leaving said road west 724.91 feet to the true place of beginning, containing seven and three hundredths (7.03) acres more or less.

Subject to the easements of State Route #83.

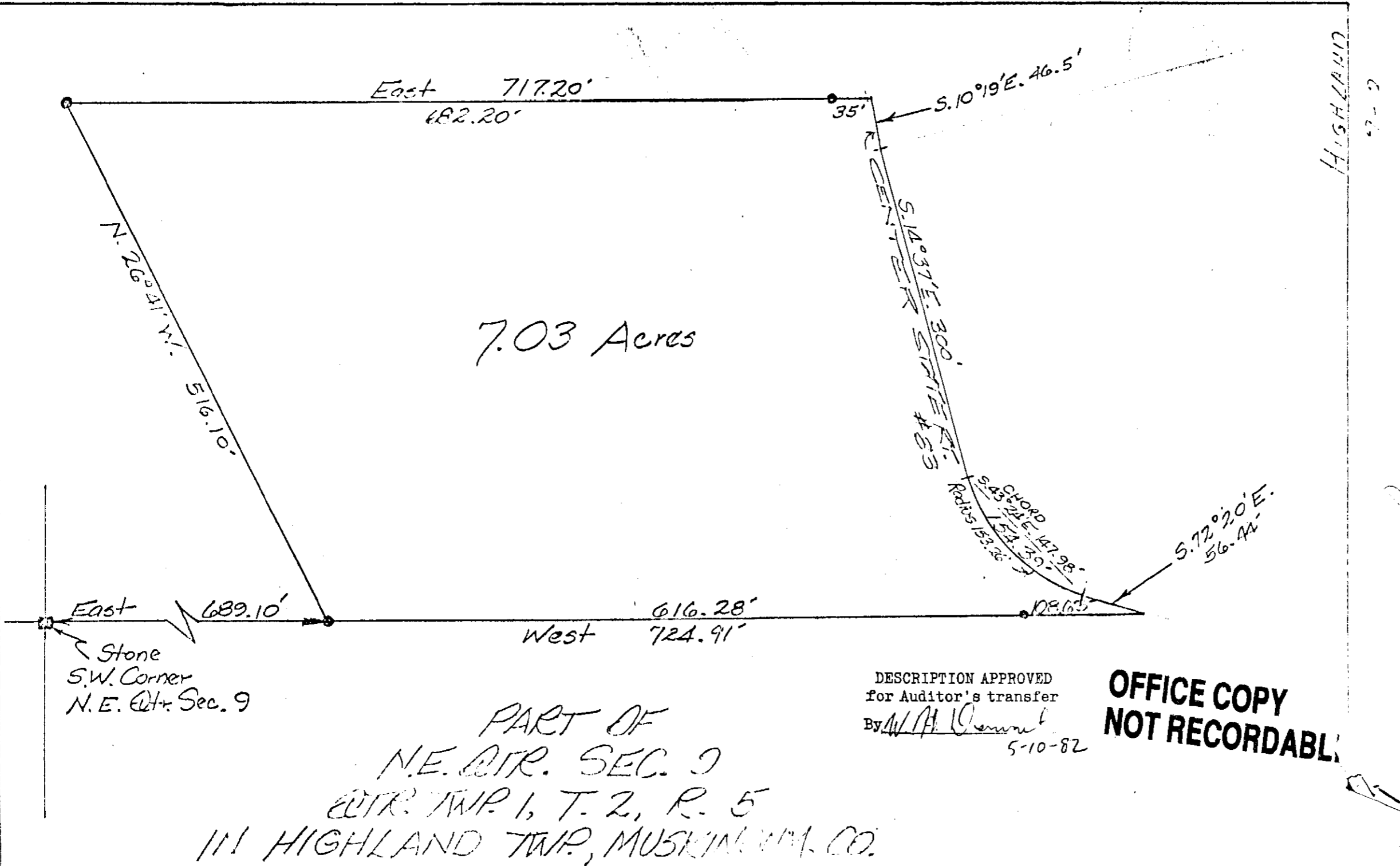
