

Part of the South and North of Section Ten, Township  
Two, Range One, of the United States Military Land, Howard  
Tract, Muskingum County, Ohio and being further described as

Commencing at a point at the South West Corner of Section  
Ten, said point being east 1.55 feet from a point marked by an  
existing concrete monument; thence North along the West line of  
Section Ten 140.42 feet to a point in the center of State Route  
209, passing a point marked by an existing iron pin at 110.45 feet;  
thence continuing North (North 00 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds  
East) along the said West line of Section Ten 21.52 feet to a  
point marked by an iron pin on the North side of State Route 209,  
said point being the place of beginning of this tract; thence  
continuing North 211.24 feet to a point marked by an iron pin  
(passing a point marked by an existing iron pin at 120.80 feet),  
said point being South 252.55 feet from a point marked by an  
existing iron pin; thence North 84 degrees 26 minutes 26 seconds  
East 25.00 feet to a point in a hedge row fence, said point  
being South 84 degrees 26 minutes 26 seconds West 0.45 feet  
from a point marked by an iron pin; thence South (South 00 degrees  
00 minutes 00 seconds West) 230.57 feet to a point marked by an  
iron pin; thence South 80 degrees 28 minutes 29 seconds East 65.13  
feet to a point marked by an existing iron pin; thence South 09  
degrees 21 minutes 03 seconds West 108.50 feet to a point marked  
by an existing iron pin on the North side of State Route 209;  
thence North 74 degrees 04 minutes 29 seconds West 114.40 feet  
to the place of beginning.

Containing 2.61 acres of land, subject to all local  
road rights-of-way.
