thence South 13 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 103.19 feet to an iron pin set on the south line of Section 10;

thence along the south line of Section 10 North 87 degrees 46 minutes 26 seconds West 16.03 feet to the place of beginning containing 0.49 acres, more or less,
