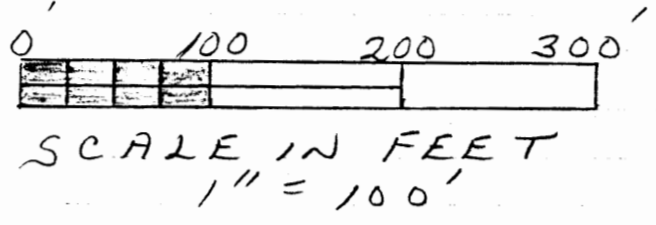


"BEARINGS ARE TO AN ASSUMED MERIDIAN AND ARE USED TO DENOTE ANGLES ONLY"

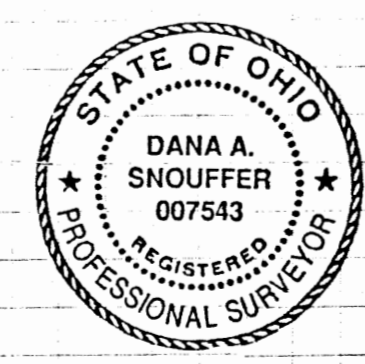
