North 53°54'26" East, 111.94 feet to a point in the centerline of Township Road 93, passing an iron pin set at 91.94 feet;

thence southeasterly along said centerline the following three (3) courses and distances;

South 30°47'07" East, 35.88 feet to a point;

South 35°05'04" East, 100.57 feet to a point;


South 41°10′43″ East, 100.67 feet to the True Place of Beginning, and containing 1.000 acres more or less, according to a survey performed by Graham Surveying in November, 1999.
