Beginning for a point of reference at a found iron pin
located at the Southeast corner of said Lot Number 4;
thence Westerly along the North line of Second Street a
distance of 18.33 feet to the True Point of Beginning
of the following described parcel hereby conveyed; thence
continuing Westerly along said North line a distance of 73.84
feet to a point marked by a found iron pin; thence
Northerly and parallel with Basin Street a distance of 165.00
feet to a point marked by a found iron pin, and being on
the South line of a public alley; thence Easterly along said
South line and parallel with Second Street a distance of
73.84 feet to a point; thence Southerly and parallel with
Basin Street a distance of 165.00 feet to the True
Point of Beginning. Containing 12,183.6 square feet, more
or less.
