Thence leaving said Preston's south line and through said Shokery lands, along a non-tangent curve to the right having a radius of 62.69 feet and an arc length of 28.58 feet, a delta angle of 26 degrees 07 minutes 15 seconds, and a chord which bears South 27 degrees 36 minutes 08 seconds West, 28.34 feet to a point on the north line of lands presently owned by Chris and Renee Pieper, (OR 1550-634);

Thence along the north line of said Pieper lands, South 54 degrees 04 minutes 30 seconds West, 40.99 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing 0.016 acres more or less;

Subject to all legal recorded easements and right of ways.

Iron pins set are 5\8 inch rebars, 30 inches long, with plastic identification caps.
