Spellman (579/372); thence, N.89°51'04"E. a distance of 248.17 feet along the North line of said Spellman lands to a found iron pin on the Northeast corner of said lands; thence, S.01°41'26"W. a distance of 322.17 feet to a found iron pin, on the southwest corner of the lands of S. & R.
