Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of section #20; thence, S.00°04′20"W. a distance of 25.00 feet along the west line of said quarter section to a point on the North line of the lands, now or formerly, owned W. & C. Spellman (579/372); thence, N.89°51′04"E. a distance of 248.17 feet along the North line of said Spellman lands to a found iron pin on the Northeast corner of said lands; thence, S.01°41′26"W. a distance of 326.09 feet to a set iron pin, BEING THE POINT OF BEGINNING;

- thence, S.01°41'26"W. a distance of 137.13 feet along the west line of the lands, now or formerly, owned by S. & H. Bowman (1086/236) to a found iron pin, on the Northwest corner of the lands, now or formerly, owned by D. Spellman (1060/267);
- thence, S.45°46'32"W. a distance of 24.27 feet along Spellman lands to a found iron pin on the Southeast corner of the lands, now or formerly, owned by D. King (1032/152)

- thence, S.45°47'27"W. a distance of 115.94 feet along said King lands to a a found iron pin;
- thence, N.43°26'42"W. a distance of 218.83 feet along the westerly line of William Spellman's lands to a set rebar;
- thence, S.88°06'27"E. a distance of 337.73 feet through the lands of William Spellman to the point of beginning.

The above described parcel contains 0.757 acres, more or less, and is subject to all legal easements and right of ways. All set iron pipes are 5/8" x 30" rebars. North is based upon an assumed meridian.


