

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Licking, bounded and described as follows:

Being a part of the North Half of the Third Quarter Township, Township 2 North, Range 9 West, United States Military Lands, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for reference, at the Northwest corner of Lot No. 2 of William Craigs survey of the south half of said third quarter township as referenced in DR 1053-45; thence along the north line of lands owned by M. E. Bishop (DR 314-290), Clay City Beverage (DR 907-262), and C. Vensil (DR 1053-45), South 88 degrees 22 minutes 01 seconds East, 1661.79 feet, to a stone found; thence along the west line of lands owned by P. and D. Dawson (DR 543-699), J. McCarty (DR 1045-251), and B. and J. Brailer (DR 808-253), North 3 degrees 33 minutes 09 seconds East, 1645.07 feet to a concrete monument and the principal place of beginning; thence along the common lines of H. and D. Miller (DR 470-501), and the U. S. A. (DR 340-475) lands the following eleven courses; 1) North 40 degrees 36 minutes 44 seconds West, 411.87 feet to an iron pin found; 2) North 40 degrees 36 minutes 3 seconds West, 382.05 feet to an iron pin found, 3) North 24 degrees 56 minutes 14 seconds West, 326.93 feet to a concrete monument found, 4) North 47 degrees 26 minutes 5 seconds East, 489.42 feet to an iron pin found; 5) North 47 degrees 26 minutes 26 seconds East, 483.29 feet to an iron pin found; 6) North 47 degrees 26 minutes 15 seconds East, 486.36 feet to a concrete monument found; 7) South 84 degrees 50 minutes 6 seconds East, 309.93 feet to a concrete monument found; 8) South 1 degree 43 minutes 32 seconds West, 59.17 feet to a concrete monument found; 9) South 85 degrees 18 minutes 24 seconds East, 199.99 feet to a concrete monument found; 10) South 22 degrees 46 minutes 14 seconds East, 364.93 feet to an iron pin found; 11) South 22 degrees 46 minutes 14 seconds East, 363.92 feet to a point in Twp. Rd. 8 (Brailer Lane), passing an iron pin set at 319.18 feet; thence across said Twp. Rd., and along the common line of B. and J. Brailer (DR 808-253), and H. and D. Miller (DR 808-253) lands, North 88 degrees 8 minutes 2 seconds West, 1137.74 feet to a stone found, passing an iron pin set at 30.73 feet; thence along the common line of said Brailer and Miller lands, South 3 degrees 33 minutes 09 seconds West, 1149.91 feet, to the principal place of beginning, containing 28.75 acres more or less, subject to all legal right of ways and applicable easements, written or implied.

Iron pins set are 5/8 inch diameter by 30 inch long rebar with plastic identification caps.

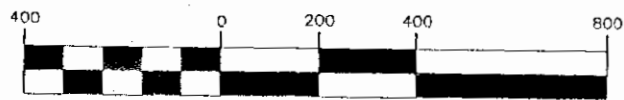

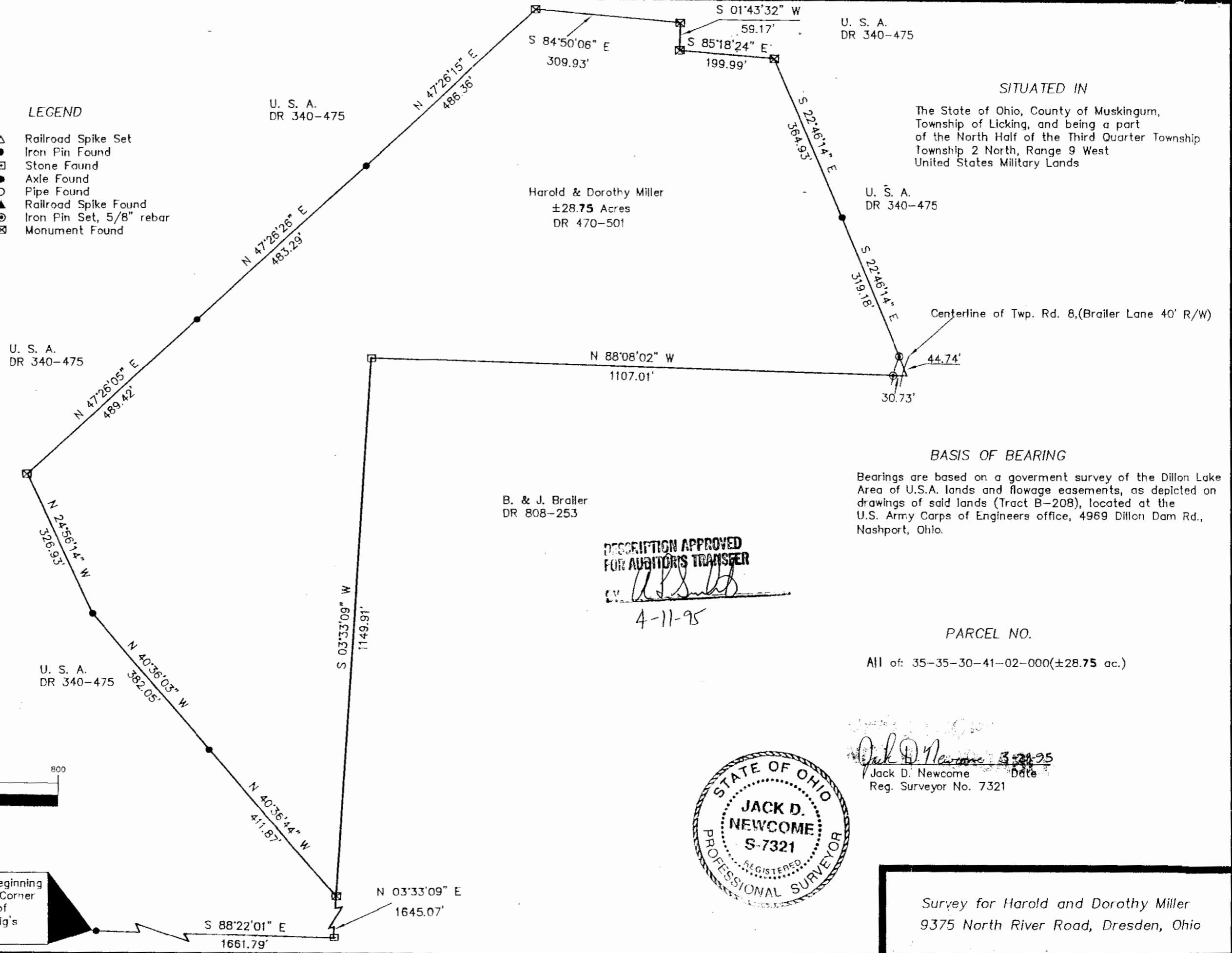
