## Tract II

Situated in the Township of Monroe, County of Muskingum, State of Ohio and being 44.661 acres in Lot 11 of the Third Quarter of Township 3 north Range 5 west of the United States Military District and being more particularly described as follows,

**BEGINNING** at a 5/8 inch capped rebar found at the southeast corner of said Lot 11 thence with the south line of said lot 11 and with the lands of Donald E. Matchett as recorded in deed volume 641 page 90 the next three calls,

- 1) N 88° 12' 32" W a distance of 810.99 feet to a 5/8 inch capped rebar found.
- 2) N 88° 12' 32" W a distance of 626.18 feet to a 5/8 inch capped rebar found.
- 3) N 88° 12' 32" W a distance of 922.61 feet to a 5/8 inch capped rebar found thence with the lands of Bethany King as recorded in official records volume 1509 page 587 N 88° 12' 32" W a distance of 135.37 feet to a point in the center of State Route 93 having passed through a 5/8 inch capped rebar found at 118.14 feet thence with the center of said State Route 93 and with a line through the lands of Daniel E. and Lisa D. Clark as recorded in official records volume 1140 page 954 the next nine calls,
- 1) N 26° 00′ 52" E a distance of 119.30 feet to a point, said point being referenced by an iron pin set which bears S 63° 59′ 08" E a distance of 30.00 feet.
- 2) thence with a tangent curve to the right having the following properties, Delta =  $30^{\circ}$  18' 25", Radius = 1183.13 feet and a chord that bears N 41° 10' 04" E a distance of 618.55 feet to a point, said point being referenced by an iron pin set which bears S 33° 40' 43" E a distance of 30.00 feet.
  - 3) N 56° 19' 17" E a distance of 89.17 feet to a point.
- 4) thence with a tangent curve to the right having the following properties, Delta =  $41^{\circ}$  13' 25", Radius = 738.15 feet and a chord that bears N 76° 55' 59" E a distance of 519.71 feet to a point, said point being referenced by an iron pin set which bears N 07° 32' 42" E a distance of 20.00 feet.
- 5) S 82° 27' 18" E a distance of 712.75 feet to a point, said point being referenced by an iron pin set which bears S 07° 32' 42" W a distance of 15.00 feet.
- 6) thence with a tangent curve to the left having the following properties, Delta =  $91^{\circ}$  58' 28", Radius = 367.17 feet and a chord that bears N 51° 33' 28" E a distance of 528.13 feet to a point.

- 7) N 05° 34' 14" E a distance of 32.75 feet to a point, said point being referenced by an iron pin set which bears S 84° 25' 46" E a distance of 30.00 feet.
- 8) thence with a tangent curve to the right having the following properties, Delta =  $26^{\circ}$  29' 41", Radius = 560.90 feet and a chord that bears N 18° 49' 04" E a distance of 257.07 feet to a point.
- 9) N 32° 03' 55" E a distance of 395.28 feet to a point thence leaving said road and with the lands of Berl E. and Barbara K. Cavinee as recorded in official records volume 1535 page 224 S 64° 41' 27" E a distance of 100.69 feet to a 5/8 inch capped rebar found having passed through a 5/8 inch capped rebar found at 33.24 feet thence with the lands of Berl E. and Barbara K. Cavinee as recorded in official records volume 1605 page 711 the next two calls,
  - 1) S 01° 52' 52" W a distance of 1181.27 feet to an iron pin set.
- 2) S 01° 52' 52" W a distance of 440.00 feet to the **BEGINNING** and containing 44.661 acres and being a part of the property conveyed in official records volume 1140 page 954 and being a part of auditors parcel # 42-50-03-24.

Subject to all leases or easements of record. Iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebar, 30 inches long capped "GARDNER PS-6884". Bearings are based on the grid meridian of the Ohio state plane south coordinate zone as determined by GPS observations.
