BEGINNING at a one inch rehar set at the northeast corner of Section #4, thence on the east line of Section #4, S 070 58 56 W, a distance of 135.32 feet to an iron pin set, thence N 83° 24' 03' W, a distance of 1061.50 feet to an iron pin set, thence N 070 12 54 E, a distance of 186,08 feet to an iron pin set on the north line of the northeast quarter of Section #4, thence on the north line of Section #4, S 80° 39' 55 E, a distance of 1001.93 feet to a one inch rebar set at the southeast corner of Military Lot #16, Township #3 north, Range #5 west, thence on the north line of the northeast quarter of Section #4, S 80° 39 55 E, a distance of 62.05 feet to the beginning and containing 3.919 acres more or less, and carried as 3.72 acres on the tax records; being a part of the property conveyed in tract #3, volume 520, page 895 of the deed records of Muskingum County, Ohio.
