Property as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1070, Page 343; thence N 85 12 45 W 1152.36 feet along the common line for said White and Oxford Oil Co. Property to an iron pin (set) at the Southwest corner of said White property, Northwest corner of said Oxford Oil Co. property and on the East line of the William Fortner property as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1117, Page 446, also being the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;
