- #1- thence S 02 17 20 W 1007.74 feet along the East line of said Section #8 to the center of Harvest Hills Road (Township Road #109), passing an iron pin (set) at 987.74 feet;
- #2- thence N 75 11 20 W 119.47 feet through said Monlux property, into said Section #8 and along the center line of said road to an unmarked point;
- #3- thence N 81 42 00 W 110.14 feet continuing along the center line of said road to an unmarked point;
- #4- thence N 88 20 30 W 95.60 feet continuing along the center line of said road to an unmarked point;
- #5. thence S 82 12 20 W 79.50 feet continuing along the center line of said road to the Southeast corner of the Phil and Donna Shirer property as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 915, Page 159;
- #6- thence N 31 51 20 W 210.12 feet leaving said road and along the East line of said Shirer property to an iron pin (found), passing an iron pin (found) at 26.35 feet;
- #7- thence S 58 11 00 W 181.77 feet along the North line of said Shirer property to the center line of said Harvest Hills Road, passing an iron pin (found) at 158.86 feet;
- #8- thence N 09 45 00 W 489.74 feet along the center line of said road to a point from which an iron pin (set) for reference bears N 81 12 30 E 19.83 feet;
- #9- thence N 08 47 40 W 433.44 feet continuing along said road to the North line of said Southeast Quarter, from which a bolt (found) at the Northwest corner of said East Half of the Southeast Quarter bears for reference N 88 18 50 W 425.92 feet;
- #10- thence S 88 18 50 E 853.97 feet along the North line of said Southeast Quarter to the place of beginning, passing an iron pin (set) at 20.00 feet, containing 16.33 acres.
