- Thence, N.04°20'50"W. a distance of 25.75 feet along said Opdyke lands to a found iron pin;
- Thence, N.86°13'58"E. a distance of 43.00 feet along said Opdyke lands to a found iron pin;
- Thence, **S.81°01'07"E.** a distance of **23.95** feet along said Opdyke lands to a found iron pin;
- Thence, **S.89°12'47"E.** a distance of **184.79** feet along said Opdyke lands to a found iron pin;
- Thence, N.49°27'25"E. a distance of 90.00 feet along said Opdyke lands to a point in the center of Little Salt Creek, passing a found iron pin at 70.00 feet;

- Thence, **8.86°18'01"W.** a distance of **45.15** feet through said Nelson lands traversing between 2 garages to the point of beginning.



Attached to and reserving from the above described parcel is a 2 foot wide easement along and perpendicular the entire last call, S.86°18'01"W. a distance of 45.15 feet, for the purpose of maintenance, repairs and access to the existing garages which the new property line goes between.
