Commencing at a stone (found) at the Northeast corner of said Northwest Quarter of Section #19, also being the common corner for the Northaast Quartar of Saction #19 and for the Southeast and Southwest Quarters of Section #12 of said Township end Range; **THENCE North 87 degrees 44 minutes 30 seconds West 833.90 feet** along the common line for said Sections #12 & #19 to the center line of said Urban Hill Road being the place of beginning of the easement herein intended to be described:

- #1- THENCE South 10 degrees 44 minutes 20 seconds East 43.55 feet into said Section #19 and along said road;
- #2- THENCE North 87 degrees 44 minutes 30 seconds West 400.16 feet though said Johnson property to an iron pin (set) on the common line for said Johnson and Foraker properties;
- #3- THENCE North 02 degrees 01 minutes 50 seconds East 42.44 feet along said common line for said Johnson and Foraker properties to an iron pin (set) on the common line for said Sections #12 & #19;
- #4- THENCE South 87 degrees 44 minutes 30 seconds East 390,53 feet along said common section line to the place of beginning.
