

Being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 4, Township two, Range six of the United States Military Lands, Salem Township, Muskingum County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at a point at the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section four; thence South 03 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 958.32 feet along the East line of the said Southwest Quarter of Section four to a point marked by an iron pin (3/4 inch pipe), said point being the place of beginning of this tract; thence continuing South 03 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 367.20 feet along the said East line of the Southwest Quarter of Section four to a point marked by an existing iron pin (5/8 inch rebar), said point being the Northeast Corner of a tract owned by Dan Boyce as recorded in Deed Book Volume 801 page 97 of the Muskingum County Deed Records; thence North 87 degrees 00 minutes 44 seconds West 161.28 feet along the North line of the said Dan Boyce tract to a point in the center of State Route 208, passing a point marked by an existing iron pin (5/8 inch rebar) at 155.42 feet; thence North 27 degrees 30 minutes 39 seconds East 88.17 feet to a point marked by an existing P/K nail in the center of State Route 208; thence North 24 degrees 28 minutes 47 seconds East 104.87 feet to a point marked by an existing P/K nail in the center of State Route 208; thence North 20 degrees 50 minutes 31 seconds East 72.32 feet to a point in the center of State Route 208; thence North 15 degrees 55 minutes 49 seconds East 86.42 feet to a point in the center of State Route 208; thence South 87 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 27.50 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing 0.752 more or less acres, subject to all legal road right-of-ways of State Route 208.

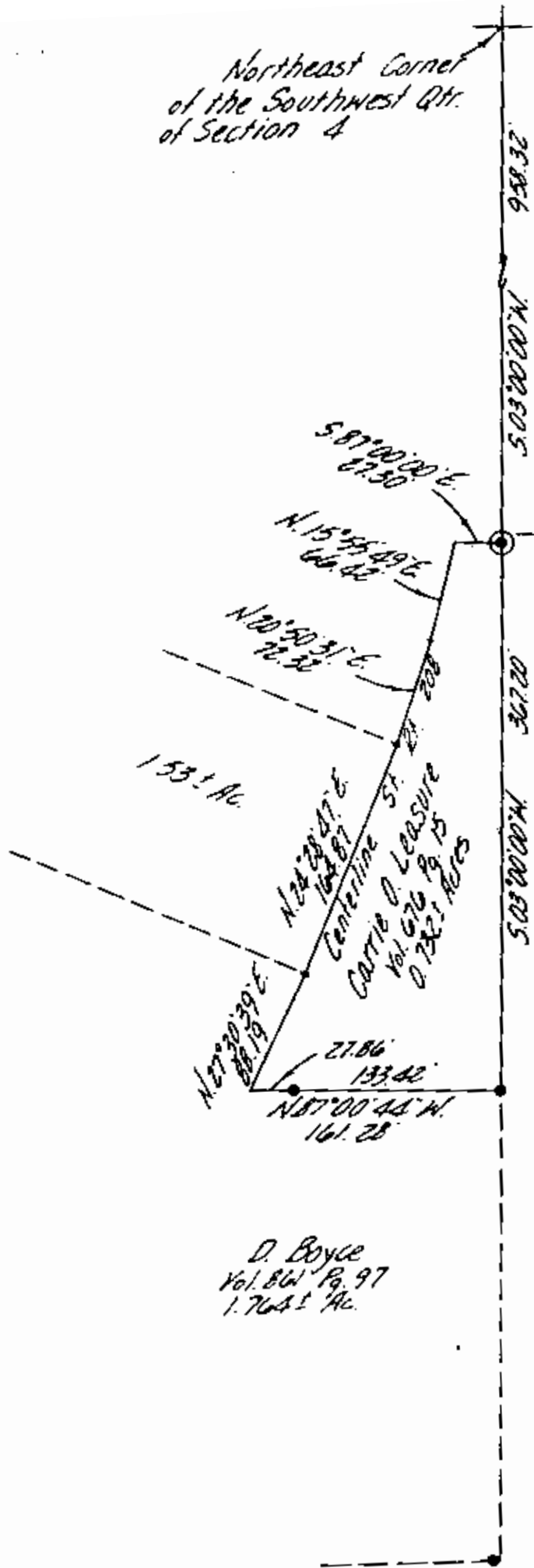
