- 6. S 18°58'27" W a distance of 96.93 feet to a point;
- 7. S 23°16'02" W a distance of 296.61 feet to a railroad spike on the south line of said quarter section, being in the northern road bed of Norfield Road (CR-64);

thence with the south line of said quarter section, N 88°15'17" W a distance of 987.31 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing a total of 25.177 acres more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements of record.

All iron pins set are 5/8 inch by 30 inch steel rebar with plastic identification caps marked MCPEEK
