Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Salem, Township 2, Range 6, part of the Northwest and part of the Southwest Quarters of Section 21, bounded and described as follows:

Being part of Earl Alexander etal. parcel number 56-90-21-11-001 Vol. 1128, Page 837.

Commencing at the Northeast Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21; Thence South 90°00'00" West 998.08 feet to a point; Thence South 15°59'00" East 7.84 feet to a point in the center of Arch Hill Road the place of beginning; Thence North 74°01'00" East 132.28 feet along Earl Alexander etal. Vol. 1128, Page 837 to an iron pin set passing an iron pin set at 20.00 feet; Thence continuing along Earl Alexander North 78°41'45" East 85.81 feet to an iron pin set; Thence South 74°01'00" West along Earl Alexander etal. Vol. 1062, Page 579, 217.80 feet to the center of Arch Hill Road; Thence North 15°59'00" West 7.00 feet to the place of beginning containing 0.0281 Acres, .0060 Acres in Southwest Quarter and .0221 Acres in Northwest Quarter.

Bearings are based on the North Line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 21 bearing South 90°00'00" West.

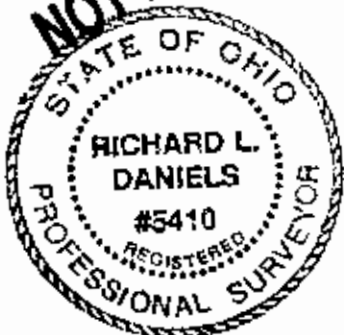

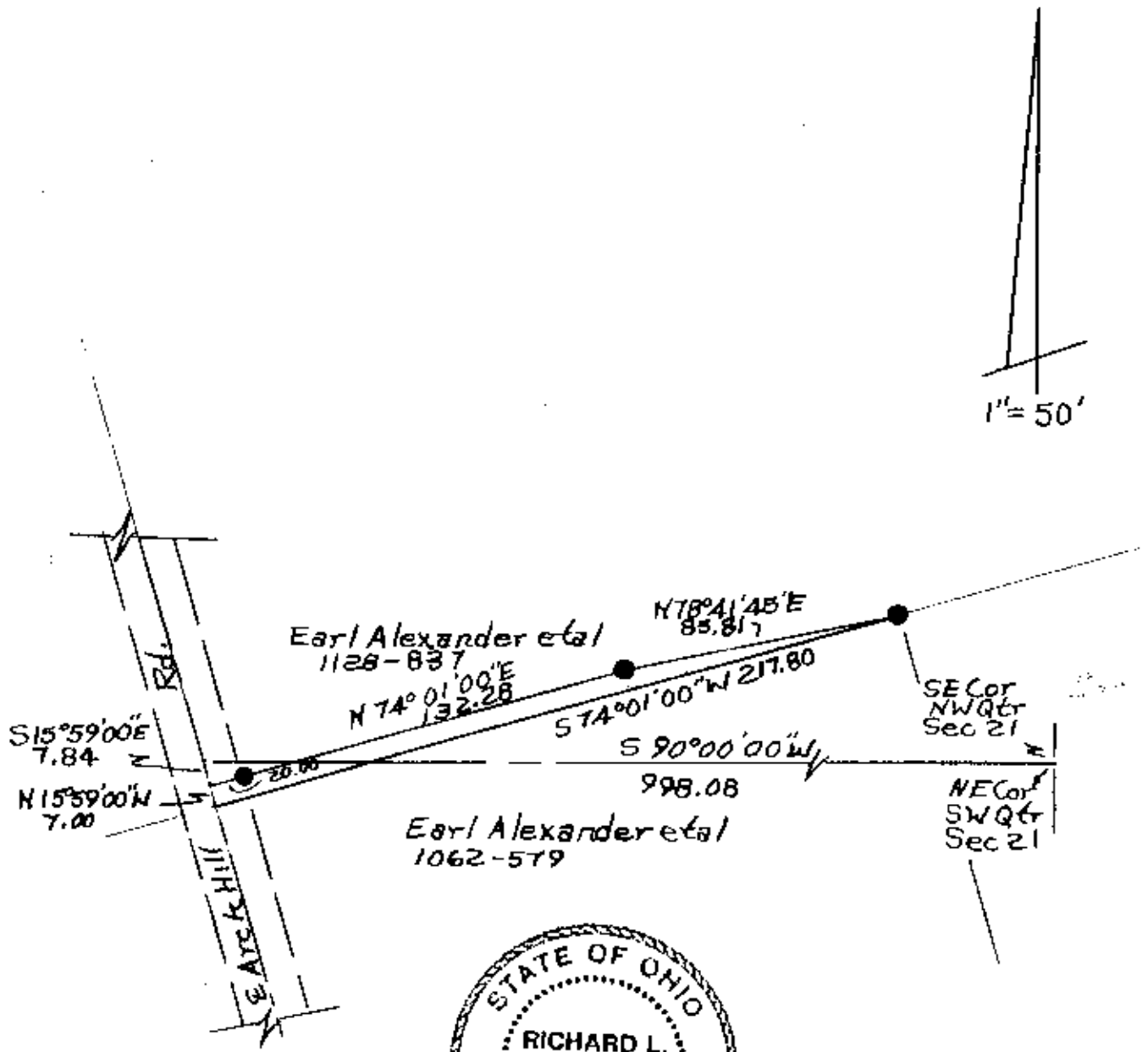
Iron pins set are number five reinf. bars 30 inches long with plastic ID caps.

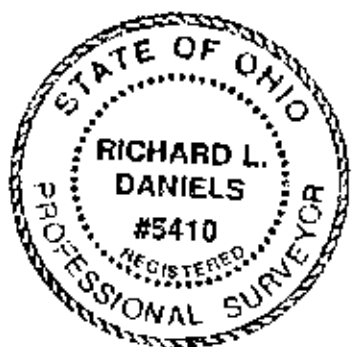
