Being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Two (2), Range six (6) of the United States Military Lands and part of property now recorded in the name of William C. Pidcock and Mary R. Pidcock in the Muskingum county Deed Records bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a stone found at the northeast corner of said southwest quarter of said section 21; thence N 87° 48' 50" W (the base of bearings for this description is State Plane Grid from a Solar Observation) along the north line of said southwest quarter 594.05 feet to an iron in set in the east line of property owned by Ronald and Hazel Ritchie (Vol. 1147., Pg. 645); thence S 12° 54' 33" E along the east line of said Ritchie property 106.32 feet to an iron pin found (capped No. 5410); thence S 77° 07' 12" W along the south line of said Ritchie property 183.81 feet to a mine bolt found at the southeast corner of property owned by Matthew and Dawn Nelson (Vol. 1138, pg. 177) and the true place of beginning for the following described parcel; thence S 12° 58' 08" E and through the lands of said William C. Pidcock and Mary R. Pidcock 50.00 feet to an iron pin set; thence S 77° 01' 52" W 215.71 feet to a point in the center of Arch Hill Road and passing through an iron pin set at 192.71 feet; thence along the center of said Arch Hill Road N 15° 21' 45" W 50.04 feet to a point; thence N 77° 01' 52" E along the south line of said Nelson property 217.80 feet to the true place of beginning and passing through a mine bolt found at 23.20 feet, containing Two-hundred-forty-nine thousandths (0.249) of an acre

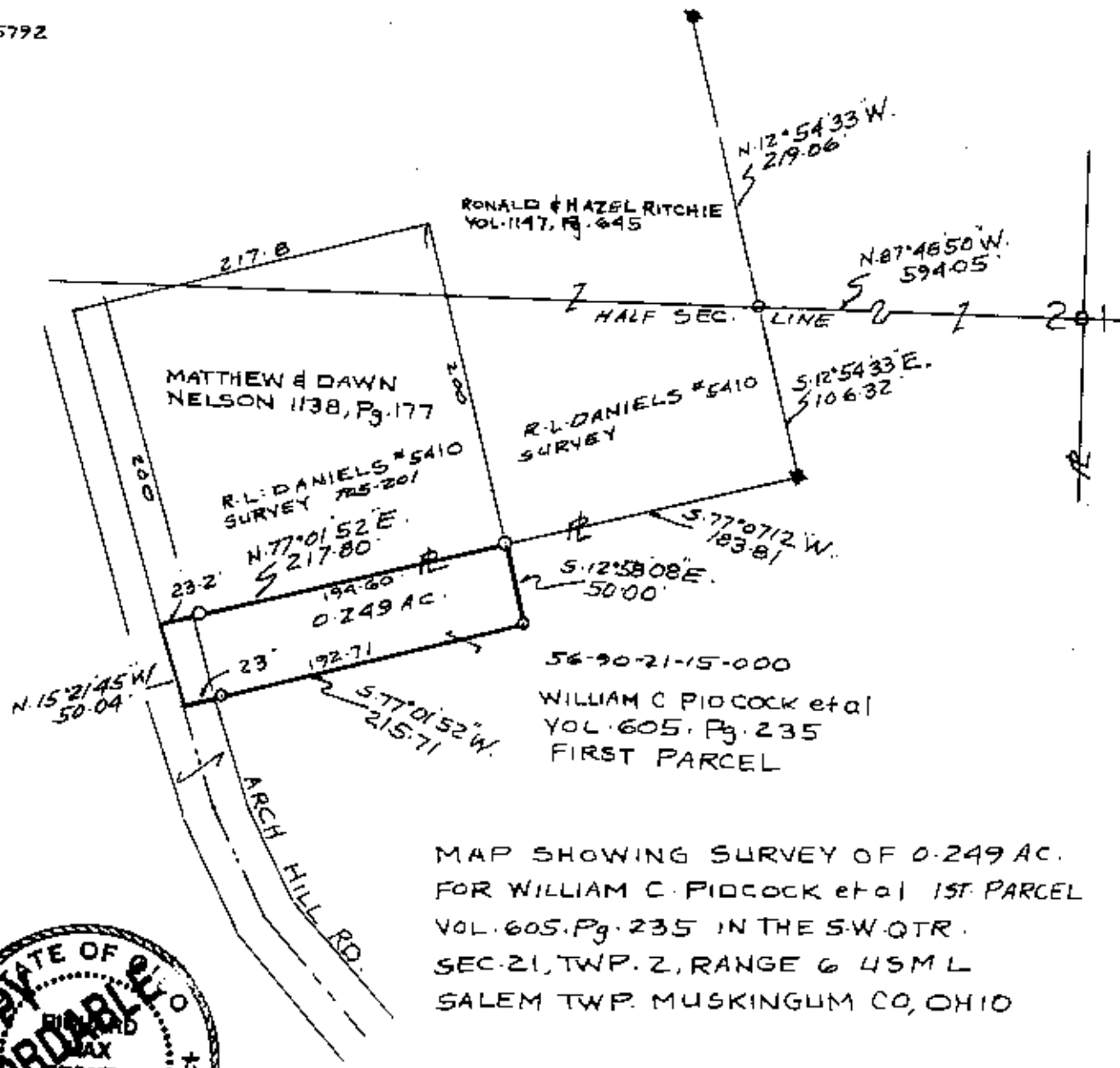
BASE OF BEARINGS IS STATE PLANE
