Commencing at an iron pipe set at the northeast corner of said Section 8 also being the northwest corner of Section 9;

thence, S 00°33'29" W, along the east line of Section 8, a distance of 380.82 feet to a point in a road, referred to as the Old Marietta Boad in the abovementioned First Parcel; being the True Point of Beginning for the herein described tract, said point referenced N 00°33'29" E, 24.18 feet from an iron pipe set on the section line;

thence, N 84°17'03" E, a distance of 189.06 feet to a point;

thence, S $00^{\circ}33^{\circ}29$ " W, a distance of 1472.88 feet to an iron pipe set, passing an iron pipe set at 15.00 feet;
