
Being a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 13, Range 12 bounded and described as follows:

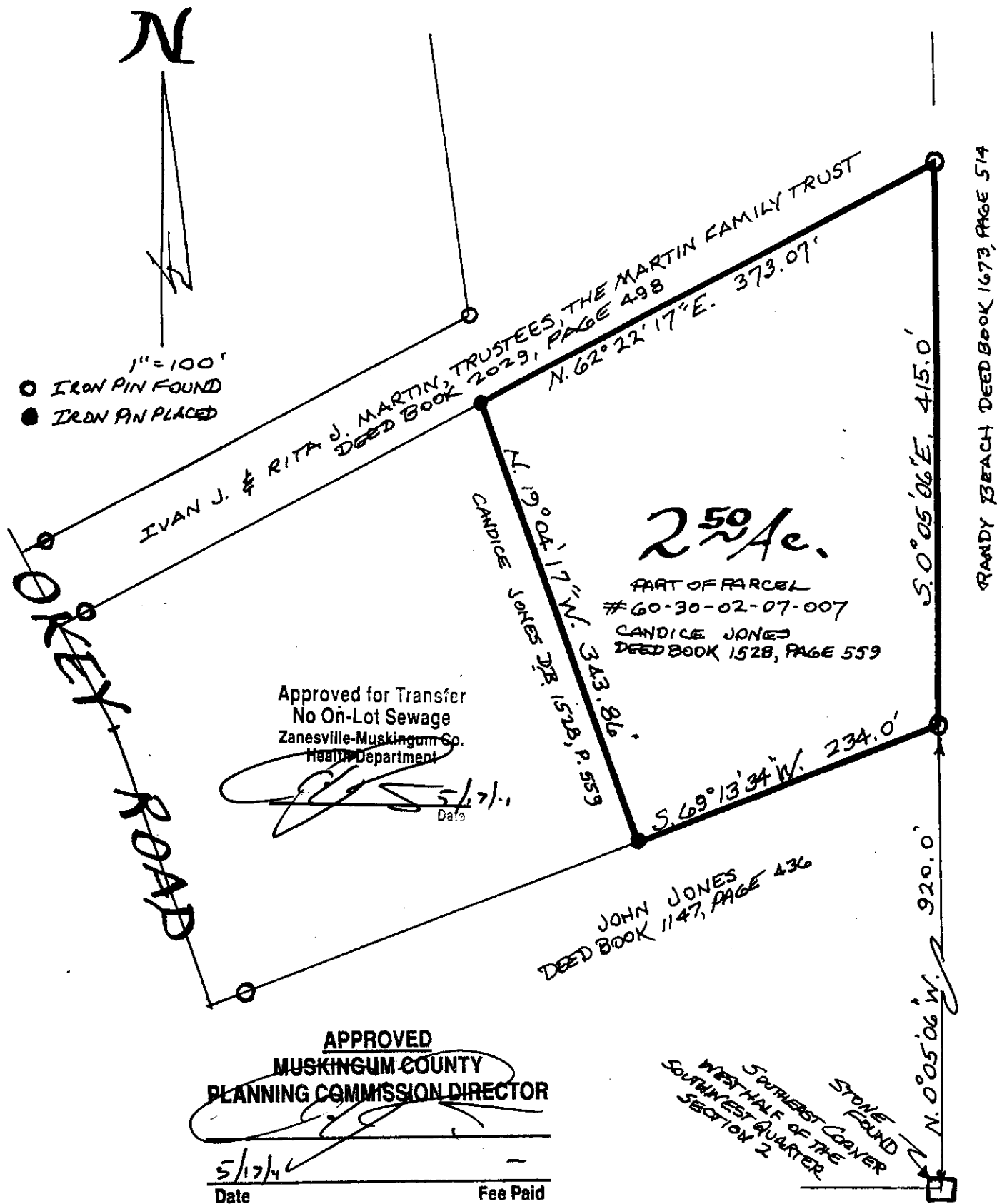
