- #1- thence N B7 34 20 W 779.31 feet along the common line for Sections #12 & #13 to an iron pin (set);
- #2- thence N 13 16 40 E 411.44 feet into Section #13 and through said D Herron and W J Herron property to an iron pin (set);
- #3- thence N 16 26 40 W 241.96 feet continuing through said D Herron and W J Herron property to an iron pin (set), passing the center line of Claysville Road (State Route #313) at 186.63 feet;
- #4- thence N 01 09 50 W 2054.36 feet continuing through said D Herron and W J Herron property to an iron pin (set) on the North line of said Southeast Quarter;
- **#5- thence** S 87 21 50 E 893.13 feet along the common line for the Northeast and Southeast Quarters of said Section #12 to an iron pin (found) at the Northeast corner of said Southeast Quarter;
- #6- thence S 02 05 30 W 1644.37 feet along the East line of Section #12 also being the common line for Salt Creek and Rich Hill Townships to an iron pin (set) at the Northeast corner of the W J Herron property recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 707, Page 222;
- #7- thence N 87 55 50 W 474.96 feet into Section #12 and along the North line of said W J Herron property to an iron pin (set) at the Northwest corner of said W J Herron property;
- **#8-** thence S 02 12 30 W 445.50 feet along the West line of said W J Herron property to the center of said State Route #313, passing an iron pin (found) at 425.68 feet;
- #9- thence S 84 50 20 E 378.20 feet along said road to an unmarked point;
- #10- thence along a curve to the left having a chord bearing \$89 59 00 E 98.28 feet, a radius of 548.00 feet, and arc length of 98.41feet continuing along said road to the East line of Section #12;
- **#11 thence S 02 05 30 W 573.40 feet** leaving said road and along the East line of Section #12 also being the common line for Salt Creek and Rich Hill Townships to the place of beginning, **containing 45.00 acres**.
