Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of section \#11: thence, N.03 $15^{\prime} 19^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{E}$. a record distance of $1085.55^{\text {feet }}$ along said quarter section line to a found iron pin; thence, $N .79^{\circ} 20^{\prime} 43^{14} \mathrm{~W}$. a distance of 604.74 feet along the North line of the lands, now or formerly, owned by Dunzweiler Developers, Inc. ( $638 / 155$ ); thence, $N .79^{\circ} 20^{\prime} 43^{\prime \prime}$ w. a distance of 177.30 feet along said Dunzweiler lands to a set iron pipe, BEING THE POINT OP BEGINNING;
thence, N. $79^{\circ} \mathbf{3 0} 0^{\prime} 43^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H}$. a distance of 367.97 feet along said Dunzweiler lands to a set iron pipe;
thence, $\mathrm{M} .10^{\circ} 39^{\prime} 17^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$. a distance of 260.13 feet through the lands of T. \& B. Anthony (1088/586) to a point in the center of Archer Lane, passing a met iron pipe at 230.13 teat;
thence, $5.82^{\circ} 18 * 51^{\mathrm{M}} \mathrm{E}$. a distance of 76.97 feet along the center of said road to a point;
thence, $\mathrm{S} .83^{\circ} 59^{\prime} 01^{m} \mathrm{E}$. a distance of 122.54 feet along the center of said road to a point:
thence, $N .73^{\circ} 46^{\prime} 12^{\circ} \mathrm{E}$. a distance of 43.04 feet along the center of said road to a point;
thence, N. $61^{\circ} 28^{\prime \prime} 8^{n} \mathrm{E}$. a distance of 26.06 feet along the center of gaid road to a point;
