

DEED DESCRIPTION

FOR

HERBERT DAILEY ETAL.

Situated in the Township of Union, County of Muskingum, State of Ohio and being 1.869 acres more or less in the Northeast Quarter of Section # 5, Township # 1 North, Range # 5 West of the United States Military Lands Survey and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a one inch rebar found at the Northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section # 5, Thence with the west line of the Northeast Quarter of Section # 5 S $03^{\circ} 28' 26''$ W a distance of 1524.77 feet to an iron pin found, Thence S $60^{\circ} 07' 59''$ E a distance of 718.40 feet to an iron pin found, Thence S $09^{\circ} 35' 42''$ E a distance of 135.95 feet to an iron pin set the BEGINNING,

Thence with a new division line through the lands of now or formerly Herbert Dailey Etal. as found in Volume 989 Page 388 the following two (2) calls:

1. N $89^{\circ} 38' 57''$ E a distance of 409.39 feet to a point in the center of a 30.00 foot wide right-of-way (having passed through an iron pin set at 389.39 feet).

2. Thence with the center of said 30.00 foot wide right-of-way S $10^{\circ} 45' 34''$ W a distance of 304.33 feet to a point, Thence with the lands of now or formerly William Heineman as found in Volume 556 Page 906 of the deed records of Muskingum County, Ohio N $63^{\circ} 47' 22''$ W a distance of 367.72 feet to an iron pin found (having passed through an iron pin found at 15.26 feet), Thence with a new division line through said Herbert Dailey Etal. N $09^{\circ} 35' 42''$ W a distance of 135.96 feet to the beginning and containing 1.869 acres more or less and being a part of the property conveyed to Herbert Dailey Etal. as found in the deed records of Muskingum County, Ohio. Known as Aut. Parcel # 66-66-01-05-01. Also the right to use and being subject to a 30.00 foot wide right-of-way described as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northeast corner of the above described property and being described along the center line thereof the following two (2) calls:

1. S $10^{\circ} 45' 34''$ W a distance of 304.33 feet to a point.
2. S $75^{\circ} 30' 01''$ W a distance of 350.10 feet to a point in the center of Fidecock Bowl.

Subject to all easements or leases of public record.

Iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebar 30 inches long, capped SPILKER LS-5862.

Bearings are magnetic and are for angle purposes only.
