Thence, S.00°02'26"E. a distance of 1182.52 feet along east line of said Quarter Section to a rebar located in the road right of way of T.R. 632 (Blackwood Lane);

Thence, N.35°35'16"W. a distance of 71.09 feet along said road to a point;

Thence, N.75°47'12"W. a distance of 45.90 feet along said road to a point;

Thence, S.78°40'35"W. a distance of 207.58 feet along said road to a point;

Thence, S.88°55'27"W. a distance of 96.24 feet along said road to a point;

Thence, on a curve to the right an arc distance of 70.00 feet with a radius of 93.28 feet, whose chord bears N.69°34'37"W. a distance of 68.37 feet along said road to a point;

Thence, N.48°04'45"W. a distance of 114.64 feet along said road to a point;

Thence, N.62°29'30"E. a distance of 64.23 feet along leaving said road and through the lands of J. & C. Blackwood (1143/789) to a set rebar;

Thence, N.18°56'59"E. a distance of 133.20 feet through said Blackwood lands to a set rebar;

Thence, N.09°35'08"E. a distance of 273.04 feet through said Blackwood lands to a set rebar;

Thence, N.78°20'19"W. a distance of 150.67 feet through said Blackwood lands to a set rebar;

Thence, N.12°35'51"E. a distance of 549.73 feet through said Blackwood lands to a set rebar;

Thence, N.81°17'34"E. a distance of 420.99 feet through said Blackwood lands to the point of beginning.
