Beginning at an iron pin (set) at the common corner for the North and South Halves of the North Half of Quarter Township #4, also being on the common line for Washington and Perry Towships and for Ranges #6 and #7 of said US Military District;

- #1- THENCE South 02 degrees 13 minutes 20 seconds West 177.54 feet along said Range and Township line to an unmarked point in the centerline of Boggs Road (County Road #108), passing an axle (found) at 149.15 feet;
- #2- THENCE along a curve to the right having, a chord bearing South 52 degrees 56 minutes 25 seconds West 119.93 feet, a radius of 1678.94 feet, and arc length of 119.96 feet, into said South Half of the North Half and along said road to an unmarked point;
- **#3- THENCE North 04 degrees 22 minutes 35 seconds West 256.24 feet** leaving said road and through said Tom property to an iron pin (set) on the common line for said North and South Haves of the North Half of Quarter Township #4, passing an iron pin (set) at 23.27 feet;
- #4- THENCE North 81 degrees 08 minutes 50 seconds East 124.60 feet into said North Half of the North Half and continuing through said Tom property to an iron pin (set) on the common line for said Townships and Ranges;
- #5- THENCE South 02 degrees 13 minutes 20 seconds West 25.00 feet along said Range and Township line to the place of beginning, containing 0.58 acres, of which 0.06 acres are within the right of way for Boggs Road (County Road #108).

The bearings within this description are based on State Plane Coordinate Grid (Ohio South 1983) derived from GPS Observations. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).
