Situated in the Northeast Quarter of Section 10. T-12, R-13. Wayne Township, Muskingum County, Ohio. Being the remaining lands of Wilbur H. Wheeler last conveyed in Deed Book 1088 page 483 of the Muskingum County Deed, and being described as follows:
