

## DESCRIPTION OF 1.021 ACRES

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, City of Zanesville, and Township of Falls, Fourth Quarter, Township 1, Range 8, and being all of that 0.808 acres described in deed to St Thomas Catholic Church, of record in Deed Volume 309, Page 311, all being of record in the Recorder

**BEGINNING** at an iron pin set a the common corner of said 0.808 acres and that 1.637 acre described in deed to William M. Welch, Jr. of record in Deed Volume 2641, Page 571, also being in the south right of way line of State Route 40;

Thence South 63°29'34" East, a distance of 181.96 feet, with the north line of said 0.808 acres and the south right of way line of State Route 40, to an iron pin set;

Thence South 51°27'34" East, a distance of 36.19 feet, with the north line of said 0.808 acres and the south right of way line of State Route 40, to an iron pin set at a corner of that 58.57 acres described in deed the Mt Calvary Cemetery Association of Muskingum County, of record in Deed Volume 73, Page 342;

Thence with the line common to said 0.808 acres and said 58.57 acres the following courses:

South 38°32'28" West, a distance of 213.38 feet, to an iron pin set;

North 56°39'35" West, a distance of 215.78 feet, to an iron pin set at a common corner of said 1.637 acres and said 0.808 acres;

Thence North 38°45′26″ East, a distance of 195.00 feet, with the line common to said 0.808 acres and said 1.637 acres, to the **POINT OF TRUE BEGINNING**, containing 1.021 acres, more or less, of which 0.505 acre of said 1.021 acres being all of Parcel 83-31-03-01-000 and 0.516 acre of said 1.021 acres being all of Parcel 17-99-04-04-000.

Subject to all easements, rights of way and restriction of record. All iron pins set are 5/8-inch rebar, 30 inches in length, with a yellow cap bearing name "CEC INC".

The above description was prepared from field measurements made under my direct supervision and in accordance with chapter 4733-37 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

The above bearings are based on the bearing of North 57°18'34" East, for the centerline of State Route 40 as established by a network of GPS observations performed in May 2018.
