Thence along the lot line, South 01 degrees 58 minutes 32 seconds West, 1306.72 feet to an iron pin set on the southeast corner of lands presently owned by Kathy S. and Donald Hunter, (OR 2003-419);

Thence along the south line of said Hunter lands, South 67 degrees 52 minutes 48 seconds West, 825.50 feet to an iron pin set in Hunt Road, (Twp. Rd. 294, Assumed R\W 40'), and the principal place of beginning;

Thence through the lands presently owned by Douglas A. and Judith A. Elekes, (DR 1153-661), the following two courses:

- 1.) South 06 degrees 45 minutes 01 seconds East, 239.73 feet to an iron pin set;
- 2.) South 75 degrees 14 minutes 31 seconds West, 335.93 feet to a point on the east line of lands presently owned by James L. Gause, (DR 1006-491), passing an iron pin set at 312.76 feet;
