

DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY FOR RAYMOND BROOKS

JOB#661-2

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Newton, Village of East Fultonham:

Being part of Section #19, Township #15, Range #14, of the Congress Lands East of the Scioto River, being part of the vacated West alley of Hoover's Addition to East Fultonham as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 34 of said county's plat records, also being all of Muskingum County Auditor's Parcel Number 47-47-60-04-04-000, and more particularly described as follows;

Commencing at a narrow gage rail (found) at the Northeast corner of Lot #11 of said Hoover's Addition; thence N 89 28 35 W 222.23 feet along the South line of Fulton Street and North lines of Lots #11, #12, & #13 of said Hoover's Addition to an iron pin (set) at the Northwest corner of Lot #13 as originally platted also being the place of beginning for the property herein intended to be described;

- #1- thence S 07 15 30 E 111.99 feet along the West line of said original West line for Lot #13 and the East line of West Alley (Vacated by Auditor's letter November 25, 1955) to an iron pin (set) at the Northwest corner of an exception described in Brent Henderson's deed as recorded in deed reference Deed Book Volume 1025, Page 145 and currently owned by George Ridenour as described in deed reference Deed Book Volume 567, Page 919;
- #2- thence S 82 44 30 W 16.00 feet crossing at right angles said vacated West alley to an iron pin (found) on the West side of said vacated West alley and East right of way line of State Route #345;
- #3- thence N 07 15 30 W 114.18 feet along the West line of said vacated West Alley and East right of way for State Route #345 to an iron pin (set) on the South line of said Fulton Street;
- #4- thence S 89 28 35 E 16.15 feet crossing said vacated West Alley and along the South line of said Fulton Street to the place of beginning, containing 0.04 acres.

The bearings within the description are based on South line of Lots #11, #12, & #13 being N 89 28 35 W as shown on a previous survey of said Lots. Bearings are shown in a format of Degrees, Minutes, and Seconds. Iron pins (set) are 5/8" rebar with identification caps (C.R.Harkness P.L.S.6885).

This description was written by Charles R. Harkness Professional Land Surveyor #6885 from an actual survey completed on June 29, 1995, in accordance with Chapter 4733-37 of the Administrative Code, and is intended to be used for the legal transfer of the property described and does not intend to describe all or any easements of record, nor encroachments unless otherwise indicated.
