

**CANNON LAND SURVEYING
7945 TWP. RD. 114 NE

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, Township of Washington, T- 1, R- 7, being a resurvey of Gerald L. & Michelle L. Snider Vol. 1025 Pg. 181, being part of Section 11, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning (by deed) at a stone at the Southwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 11; thence along the Mid Section Line South 89 Degrees 59 Minutes 00 Seconds East 2242.78 feet to an iron pin found and the place of beginning; thence North 00 Degrees 01 Minutes 00 Seconds East 200.16 feet to an iron pin found; thence South 89 Degrees 59 Minutes 00 Seconds East 436.50 feet to a point in the centerline of Co. Rd. 191 (Jackson Rd.), passing an iron pin found at 405.55 feet; thence along said centerline the next 3 courses to points: South 09 Degrees 27 Minutes 46 Seconds West 64.90 feet; thence South 18 Degrees 47 Minutes 58 Seconds West 75.27 feet; thence South 29 Degrees 43 Minutes 21 Seconds West 78.81 feet; thence leaving said centerline North 89 Degrees 25 Minutes 07 Seconds West 362.58 feet to the place of beginning, passing iron pins found at 21.90 feet and at 307.32 feet, containing 1.896 acres, more or less, subject to all legal highways and easements.

Iron pins set are 5/8 inch rebar 30 inches long, with plastic ID caps.

Bearings are based on the Mid Section Line of Section 11 as being North 89 Degrees 25 Minutes 07 Seconds West.
