Khune (reference Volume 900, Page 61); thence North $88^{\circ}37'00''$ East 1747.78 feet (passing through an iron pin found, $[1\frac{1}{4}''$ axle] at 534.71 feet, said point locating the Southeast corner of said 46.135 acre tract, and also passing through a railroad spike in the center of T.R. No. 234 at 1138.89 feet) to an iron pin ($1\frac{1}{4}''$ axle) found in the East line of Section No. 32, Wayne Township; thence North $88^{\circ}35'37''$ East 1297.80 feet (passing through an iron pin $[1\frac{1}{4}''$ axle] found locating the Southeast corner of a 50.946 acre tract, reference Volume 606, Page 161, belonging to Terry L. Mayer at 653.73 feet) to the place of beginning and containing 86.411 acres, more or less.

There being 47.692 acres in Section No. 32 of Wayne Township and 38.719 acres in Section No. 33 of Salt Creek Township.
