

NOTICE TO PUBLIC – October 14, 2016

UPCOMING PROJECT – Cannelville Road (CR 7) Bridge Replacement

The Muskingum County Engineer's Office and the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) are developing plans to replace the bridge over Brush Creek approximately 0.1 miles west of State Route 555 on Cannelville Road (CR 7). The bridge has a small sign attached to the guardrail labeled BRC C0007 6035 256. As part of ODOT's normal Project Development Process we are required to notify adjacent property owners, school district and emergency services to solicit comment and concerns regarding the improvement. Your comments can assist the Muskingum County Engineer's Office and ODOT in identifying issues of local concern, which will help us with the continued planning of this improvement to the local roadway system. We are also seeking comments, information or concerns about social, environmental and economic impacts of this project. Environmental information includes cultural resources (archaeological and history/architecture resources), ecological features, and hazardous materials locations we may not be aware of already. The existing steel beam bridge built on concrete abutments with a steel deck and asphalt surface will be replaced with a galvanized steel beam bridge with a composite concrete surface on concrete abutments. As a result of the bridge replacement, the bridge will be closed during construction for approximately 60 days with traffic detoured. Access will be maintained to driveways within the project limits during construction.
