Thence along the north line of said Celuch, and Butler, South 87 degrees 46 minutes 42 seconds East, 1312.59 feet to an iron pin found, on the northwest corner of lands presently owned by Thomas D. and Amber M. Gee, (OR 2384-207), and the principal place of beginning;

Thence through the lands presently owned by Joseph A. Celuch, and Brenda K. Butler, (OR 2587-436) the following two courses:

- 1.) North 02 degrees 25 minutes 25 seconds East, 161.66 feet to an iron pin set;
- 2.) North 56 degrees 14 minutes 03 seconds East, 358.00 feet to the centerline of Hamby Hill Road, (Co. Rd. 38, R\W 40'), passing an iron pin set at 338.63 feet;

Thence along the centerline of said road, South 36 degrees 18 minutes 27 seconds East, 50.00 feet to a point on the northwest corner of lands presently owned by Thomas D. and Amber M. Gee, (OR 1740-491);

Thence along the west line of said Gee lands, South 08 degrees 56 minutes 01 seconds East, 341.98 feet to an iron pin found, on the north line of lands also presently owned by Thomas D. and Amber M. Gee, (OR 2384-207), passing an iron pin found at 47.96 feet;
