Real Estate situated in the Town of Dresden, in the County of Muskingum, and in the State of Ohio and bounded and described as follows:

Being a part of Out Lot #81 on the Town plat of Dresden, as shown in Plat Book A-0, page 128 and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 1/2 inch rebar found at the Northeast corner of Lot #8 of the Mitchell Hill Subdivision, as said subdivision is recorded in Plat Book 16, pages 114 and 115, Muskingum County Plat Records, said 1/2 inch rebar found being the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING of the land herein described;

thence, with the line between Jefferson Township and the Village of Dresden, the following two courses:

1. thence, with the North line of said Lot #8, N.82°26'00"W. 240.00 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar found;
2. thence, with the North line of Lot #33 of the said subdivision, N.82°16'00"W. 133.50 feet to a point;

thence, with the property lines of Mitch A. & Valeria S. Mitchell, {D.B. 906, pg. 247}, the following five courses:

1. thence, N.76°16'52"E. 28.05 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found;
2. thence, N.10°12'40"W. 129.35 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found;
3. thence, N.15°32'00"W. 79.13 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found;
4. thence, S.77°32'30"W. 93.84 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found bent;
5. thence, S.77°57'21"W. 74.91 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found;

thence, through the property of Charles Mitchell, Jr., et al. ux., {D.B. 566, pg. 242} and {D.B. 532, pg. 105}, the following four courses:

1. thence, N.12°25'24"E. 110.94 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;
2. thence, N.19°24'33"E. 193.56 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;
3. thence, N.45°32'00"E. 95.54 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;
4. thence, N.00°59'10"E. 133.34 feet to a 3/4 inch iron pipe found;

thence, with the property lines of Kenneth E. & Mary Ann Wolford, {D.B. 640, pg. 115}, the following two courses:

1. thence, S.30°26'42"E. 237.50 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;
2. thence, N.75°25'18"E. 111.08 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;

thence, with the N. 1/2 inch rebar line or state route #40, the following three courses:

1. thence, S.12°45'00"E. 100.51 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;
2. thence, S.56°55'11"E. 100.00 feet to a 1/2 inch rebar set;
3. thence, S.11°45'00"E. 101.00 feet to the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING, continuing until after one or less, being subject to all easements and restrictions of record or implied, if any.

The above wills out tract contains 4.433 acres, more or less, in Auditor's Parcel #33-30-29-10-003, and 1/2 acre, more or less, in Auditor's Parcel #33-30-29-10-004.


