

ADAMS LN.

situated in the State of Ohio, County of Hamilton, Town Ship of Springfield.

Being a part of the northwest, the northeast and the southeast quarters of Section Eleven (11), Township 14, Range 116E, Township (14) of the Congress Lands east of the Scioto River and part of parcel one two and all remaining of parcel three as properly owned by Land Investment Designs, Inc. and Recorded in Deed Book 603, Page 157 of the Muskingum County Deed Records bounded and described as follows.

Beginning at an iron pin found at the center of said section 11 thence N 87 16 13 W (the base of bearings for this description is true north as an observation of the sun) along the south line of said northwest quarter and the north line of a 2 1/4 acre parcel owned by Joyce and Sue Appleson (Vol. 945 Pg. 106) and the north line of a 9 7/8 acre parcel owned by William and Rebecca Merrill (Vol. 843, Pg. 134) a distance of 1172.84 feet to a stake found thence N 85 06 48 E along the south line of said northwest quarter of section 11 and the north line of a 4 08 acre parcel owned by Harry H. L. Linn (Vol. 1014 Pg. 152) and the east line of said parcel and the westerly corner of a 2 1/4 acre parcel owned by Mark Gussler (Vol. 1070, Pg. 77) thence following the westerly line of said Gussler parcel the following true courses and distances:

- 2- N 20 42 14 W 175.37 feet to an iron pin found
- 3- N 04 07 38 E 244.78 feet to an iron pin found
- 4- N 00 30 32 E 168.23 feet to an iron pin found
- 5- N 00 31 43 W 50.00 feet to an iron pin found at the southeast corner of a 0.99 acre parcel owned by Victor Henry (Vol. 738, Pg. 23); thence continuing N 30 51 43 W along the east line of said Henry parcel 259.82 feet to a point in the center of Archer Lane and passing through an iron pipe found at 224.83 feet; thence S 67 12 27 W along the center of said Archer Lane 55.82 feet to a bolt set; thence S 53 40 10 E along the westerly line of a 1.00 acre parcel owned by Jack and Darla Fleming (Vol. 929, Pg. 101) a distance of 357.01 feet to an iron pin set at the southeast corner of said parcel and passing through an iron pin set in the center of an existing drive at 125.00 feet; thence S 79 00 43 E 1343.27 feet to an iron pin set on the east line of said northwest quarter of section 11 and passing through an iron pin set at 744.52 feet; thence S 3 11 49 E along the east line of said quarter and the east line of Deens Addition (Plat Book 2, Page 122) a distance 584.43 feet to an iron pin set at the southeast corner of said Deens Addition; thence S 87 10 07 E and passing into the northeast quarter of section 11 and along the south line of said Deens Addition 530.10 feet to an iron pin set; thence S 4 28 19 W along the east line of a 21 3/4 acre parcel owned by John Hiltzbrand (Vol. 1029, Pg. 251) a distance of 629.62 feet to an iron pipe found and passing from the northeast quarter into the southeast quarter of section 11 at 501.47 feet; thence N 85 07 17 W along the north line of a 12 00 acre parcel owned by Edward Keiser (Vol. 827, Pg. 290) 108.87 feet to a one inch straight stake found on the west line of said southeast quarter of section 11; thence N 2 18 14 E along the west line of said quarter and the east line of a 27 85 acre Appleson parcel a distance of 317.62 feet to the place of beginning containing fifty and sixty hundredths (50.60) acres.

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
