

Being a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section seven, Township one, Range five, Union Township, Muskingum County, Ohio and being further described as follows:

Commencing at the most Southerly Corner of Lot number fifteen of Workman's Addition to the Village of Norwich as recorded in Deed Book "I", page 518 and also shown on an Annexation Plat of the Village of Norwich as recorded in Plat Book nine, page 57, 58 of the Records of Muskingum County; thence South 40 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East 13.00 feet to a point on the South side of an alley; thence South 50 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West 20.00 feet to a point in the center of County Road number 105; thence along the said center of County Road number 105 with a curve to the right having a radius of 1713.50 feet (chord bearing South 35 degrees 33 minutes 00 seconds East 265.10 feet) an arc distance of 265.57 feet to a point in the center of County Road number 105, said point being the place of beginning of this tract; thence continuing along said center line of County Road number 105 with a curve to the right having a radius of 1713.50 feet (chord bearing South 29 degrees 09 minutes 48 seconds East 110.70 feet) an arc distance of 110.72 feet to a point; thence South 27 degrees 12 minutes 00 seconds East 33.63 feet to a point in the center of County Road number 105; thence South 57 degrees 33 minutes 04 seconds West 324.41 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 inch iron pipe, passing a 3/4 inch iron pipe at 20.08 feet; thence North 36 degrees 01 minute 04 seconds West 45.50 feet to a point marked by an existing iron pipe, said point being the Northeast Corner of a 0.75 acre tract owned by Roland and Marilyn Kemble recorded in Volume 805 page 267 of the Muskingum County Deed Records; thence North 37 degrees 40 minutes 50 seconds East 15.03 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 inch iron pipe; thence North 41 degrees 27 minutes 59 seconds West 62.71 feet to a point marked by a 3/4 inch iron pipe), said point being the Southwest Corner of a 0.94 acre tract owned by Wanda Jean Smith as recorded in Volume 850-539 of the Muskingum County Deed Records; thence North 50 degrees 10 minutes 40 seconds East 334.57 feet to the place of beginning, passing a point marked by a 3/4 inch iron pipe at 318.17 feet.

Containing 0.903 more or less acres, subject to all legal road right-of-ways.
